Dear all,

What a perfect week for Year 7 to go to camp. They have had three glorious, sunny days and from all reports the camp seems to be going well. Year 7 will return this afternoon at approximately 3.00 pm for pick up. BRIEF Instructions for parents/guardians FYI

Full instructions and examination timetable can be found on the school calendar.

• Morning examinations commence at 8:55 am promptly. This is the time that reading time commences.

Your student will need to be at school on the COLA at least **20 minutes before** the scheduled examinations so that all students can walk to the RSC, D block or portables and be seated and ready in the examination room at 8.55.

- Students with disability provisions you will also be sent from the COLA to either P5 or P6.
- All students will need to have all the equipment required for each exam with them. This may include pens, pencils, rulers, erasers, calculators, drawing equipment. Students are not permitted to borrow items from other students.
- If your student is sick during an examination and is not able to continue, they must raise their hand and inform the supervisor of your problem. If they need to leave the examination due to illness, they should visit a doctor and obtain a medical certificate.
- If they are sick on the day of the examination and are unable to attend, the student or parent must telephone the school to inform them of the problem and the student will need to see a doctor **on that day** for a medical certificate which should be presented to the Head Teacher of the exam missed on the next day the student returns to school.
- If there is a misadventure which prevents the student from being able to sit the examination, please inform the school as soon as possible of the problem and present documentary evidence of the misadventure to the school **on the first day the student returns**. Your student **may** be able to sit the examination on an alternate day.
- Students are encouraged to only be present on school grounds when they have a timetabled examination. However, if students have more than one examination on the same day, a study room timetable will be displayed outside the Stage 5 Deputy Principal's office.
