PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE Friday 19 August

Week 5 is almost over and we are half way through term three, and already there has been so many opportunities for our students and as the term continues so will the events.

We have now completed three subject selection evenings for Years 8, 9 and 10 and thank you to all of you who attended we had fantastic turn-outs at each evening where lots of great questions were placed on the chat. Year 7 students have chosen their language for Year 8, 2023 and at the end of term Year 11 will decide what the final make-up of subjects for their HSC year will be.

Year 11 have two weeks before the commencement of their final exams (starting week 8). Today we held a year group assembly and discussed the location of the exams, special provisions and the process of dropping a 2 unit subject and/or picking up extension or further extension subjects. Most of the exams will take place in the Returned Servicemen's Club auditorium. However for the very large exams of English and mathematics, the Advanced exams will be in the RSC and the standard and disability provisions will be at school.

This Monday all Year 10 students will have an opportunity for vaccinations. Students in Years 8 and 11 who missed the meningococcal ACWY will have a catch up opportunity as well.

This coming Sunday, Year 9 will be at school at 7.15pm ready to head off to the first ski camp. The online snow cam is showing lots of snow at Perisher which is good news for our students.
