University of Sydney ARTiculate - PDHPE: Health Equity in Australia

Today

3 August 2023

Although Australia provides ‘universal’ healthcare through the publicly funded Medicare scheme, enormous health disparities exist among and across our population. Clinical services are often unequally available according to the ‘postcode lottery’ of where you were born. Numerous elements contribute to widely divergent health outcomes including sex, race/ethnicity, socioeconomic and migrant status, educational attainment and occupation, access to housing, the built environment and transport infrastructure, legacies of colonialism, and more. In this seminar, Katherine Kenny, Kellie Burns, Cristyn Davies and Imogen Harper will discuss how health is socially patterned – not just individually achieved or experienced – in ways that systematically advantage some people over others. In addition to cases exploring some of the causes and experiences of inequality, we also highlight how better health equity might be achieved, especially for young people, in Australia today.

University of Sydney ARTiculate - Modern History: Wartime Diplomacy and China's Status as a Great Power

31 August 2023

This webinar will discuss China's diplomatic strategies during its war of resistance against Japan and World War II. We will consider shifting relationships with great powers such as the Soviet Union and the United States, and the way that these relationships were complicated by China's own social divisions and the Guomindang's rivalry with the CCP. Although often disappointed with the support it received from abroad, China was also surprisingly successful in inserting itself into international negotiations during WWII. Ultimately, we will be interested here in how China emerged from the war as itself one of the world's “powers”, and as such obtained a seat among the permanent members of the newly formed UN Security Council.
